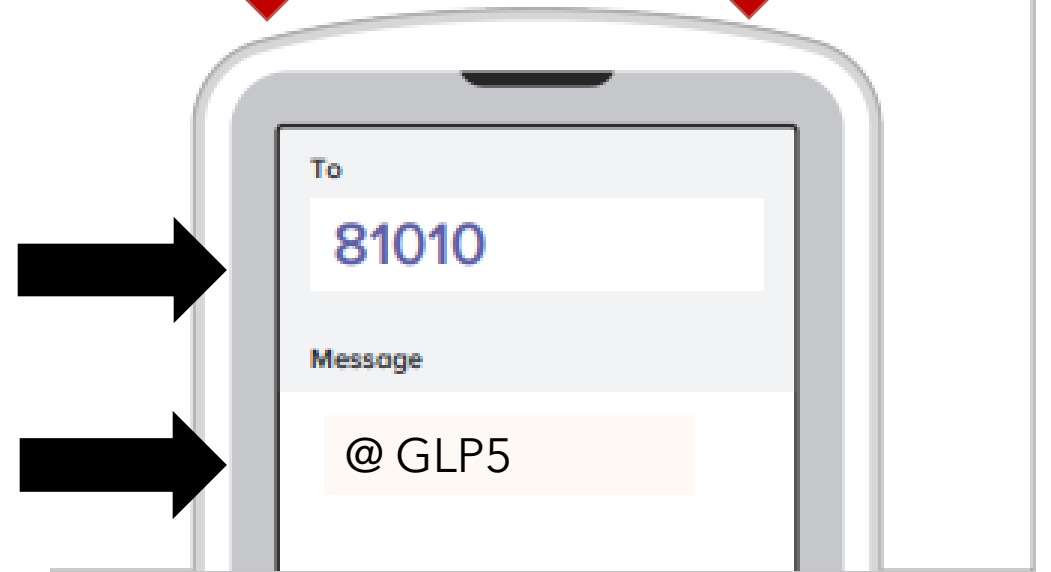

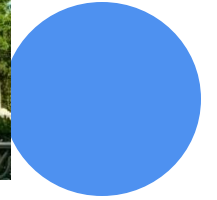
Dress Code:

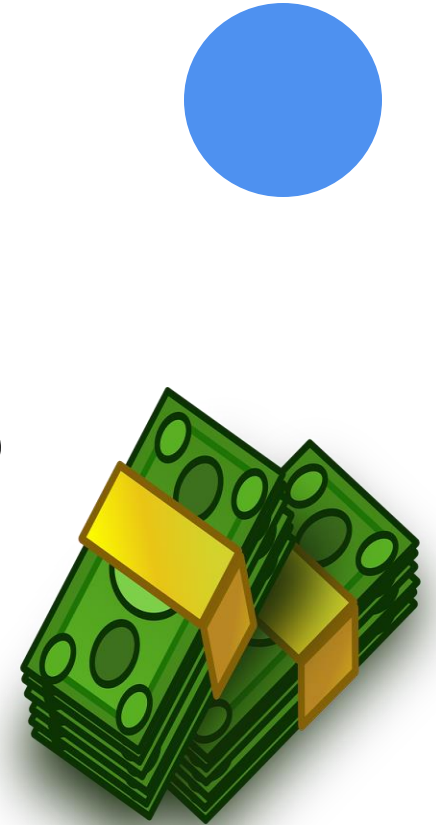

Online through the OSP (available through your parent or student portal)

Online School Payments (OSP)

1. Login to the **MDCPS Parent Portal**
2. Click on **Apps/Service/Sites**
3. Click on the **OSP** link
4. Click on your **Child's School Level**
5. Click on the **Name of your Child's School**

This will display the Activities available for purchase.



- Students and chaperones **MUST** wear the fifth-grade shirt.
- Students may bring a jacket to wear on the bus since it does get cold on the bus. Students may also bring a small pillow. However, **blankets are not permitted.**
- Students may pack their own breakfast to eat on the bus. (Disposable please)
- Students may bring snack for the bus ride (going and coming back).
- Only water is allowed on the bus – no juices or sodas.
- **ABSOLUTELY NO GUM** is allowed on the bus.
- Students are responsible for their own trash. **NO TRASH** should be left on the bus at any time.
- Students may bring money to purchase souvenirs from the gift shop as well as snacks (lunch and dinner are included).



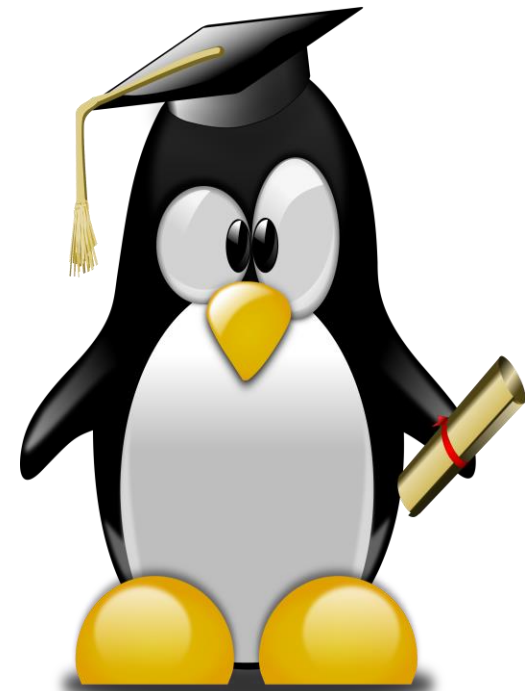
- Students are to be always with their designated chaperone and group. Students are not allowed to go off on their own at any time.
- Restrooms will be used at the service plaza not on the bus. The bus restroom will be reserved for emergencies ONLY.
- All items may stay on the bus while we are at the rest stops and park.
- Electronics are allowed AT YOUR OWN RISK. Neither teachers, nor chaperones will hold or be responsible for anyone's belongings.
- Drawstring/lightweight backpacks are allowed in the park (will need to go through metal detectors/searched).
- Parents may follow the bus or meet us at the park. Remember if you are following the bus; do not get in between the buses.
- **The school reserves the right to exclude any student who misbehaves in class from the trip or any other fifth grade activity without the right of a refund.**
